

Types of papers:

Original Articles, Which reports the results of original research and is a comprehensive contribution to the subject, including introduction, experimental information and discussion of results.

Short Communications, Describing a novel case or concise account of new and significant findings to inform readers of preliminary or limited research results. It must be in shorter pages and lower citation and do not merit the status of an original article. Short communications are considered for a quicker publication procedure.

Review Articles, A review is a critical evaluation of a defined subject of recent and current research in a specific field to which the author has made notable contributions. Using from more influential references is essential and makes it worthwhile for extending a comprehensive view related to subject.

Format of electronic submissions

An electronic version of the text must be provided exclusively by e-mail to submission@ijmcm.ir. This e-mail address is being protected from spambots. You need JavaScript enabled to view it, in Microsoft Word. It must be accompanied by a covering letter, stating the title of manuscript and contact details of solely the correspondence author. Microsoft Word 2007 is not acceptable format.

Upon receipt of paper submission, the Editor sends an e-mail of confirmation to the corresponding author within 1-3 working days. If you fail to receive this confirmation, your submission/email may be missed.

The authors bear full responsibility for the contents of their contribution. All works get peer-reviewed by our at least two referees and probably selected referees that author suggests. The reviewing process takes place at maximum 50 days after receiving the manuscripts. The final decision whether a specific manuscript may be accepted for publication in ***International Journal of Molecular and Clinical Microbiology***

will be made by our editors. Authors are encouraged to suggest at least three referees (including, phone number and e-mail address) to be added to our list from which referees will be selected. Accepted manuscripts are published in current or next issue regarding to receive the proofs back from the author and number of accepted papers. A copy of the proofs will be sent to corresponding author and it must be returned before 5 days. The editorial board of ***International Journal of Molecular and Clinical Microbiology*** reserves the right to reject manuscripts that are not in the aim and scope of the journal, or do not meet the requirements for publication.

Papers published or under consideration elsewhere will not be accepted for publication in ***International Journal of Molecular and Clinical Microbiology*** ; but publication the same works as an abstract or extended summary does not preclude publication in full in this journal.

Authors for whom English is a second language should have their manuscript checked by a native-English speaker familiar with the terminology of the current field. The manuscript's file should have the name of the corresponding author.

Layout

- **Title page**, including title, running head (short title) not exceeding 45 letters with spaces, and author(s) affiliations, e-mail address and telephone number (with country and area code) for corresponding author; it must be written in a separate page. Title should be concise and informative. Avoid abbreviations and formulae where possible.

- **Abstract**, An abstract not exceeding 250 words should state the aim of the study, the main findings, and how the results were interpreted. Include 3 to 5 keywords; it must be written in a separate page.

- **Body of the paper**, including Introduction, Material and methods, Results, Discussion (or/ results and discussion together), Acknowledgements and References. Submitted papers must not be longer than 25 manuscript pages for original articles and 10 pages for short communication. Insert the Figures and Tables in appropriate location in the text for all types of papers. The manuscript should provide in double-spaces, numbering the pages at the bottom

and margins of at least 2.5 cm (same for the figures and tables) and justified margin. Use a standard 12 point typeface Times New Roman throughout the manuscript.

- **References**, the maximum references citation in paper must be less than 40 and 20 references for original articles and short communication, respectively.

Citation in text: (McCarthy, 2002); (McCarthy and Jones, 2002); (McCarthy et al., 2002); (Jones, 1999; McCarthy et al., 2002; McCarthy and Jones, 2002).

More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters "a", "b", "c", etc., placed after the year of publication.

Listing references: All references should be listed consecutively as they appear in the text, as follows:

- Acknowledgements, the scientific and material contributions of others to the work should be acknowledged. Any grant supports should be listed and permission for reproduction of published material should be acknowledged.

Tables and Figures

All Tables and Figures used should be referred in the text in a similar order. Indicate the appropriate location of each Table and Figure in the manuscript and they should be numbered. All Figures must be sharp with high contrast. The author can provide the color images and graphs with no payment for their publication expenses. Figure files (graphs and pictures) should have the JPG, EMF or TIFF format and those scanned should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi and incorporate figures in manuscript.

Authors will be required to sign a Copyright Transfer Agreement (CTA) for all papers accepted for publication. Signature of the CTA is a condition of publication and papers will not be passed to the publisher for production unless a signed form has been received by e-mail to editor@ijmcm.ir
